Information on Submission of Papers

The Students for Students Committee invites the submission of abstracts for presentations for the 2009 Conference.

Abstracts need to be submitted no later than Monday, **6th July, 2009**.

Presenters are asked to identify which of the following major perspectives their workshop/paper/poster will address:

The 4 streams for the workshops are:

- **CONNECT:** networking skills, relationship building, mentoring, engaging and connecting with the world we live in, volunteerism
- **INSPIRE:** Speakers who have inspiring stories. Faculty based speakers who have gone on to achieve in their career, Practical tips on how to keep motivated and thrive Personal testimonies and practical applications
- **PERSEVERE:** How to overcome hardships in being a leader and seeking to achieve goals, how to keep going when the going gets tough, goal planning
- **ACHIEVE:** How to have an impact at a local/global level, what we can do today to achieve and assist for the greater good

Conference Sessions

- **Workshop:** 30 minutes [includes 10 minutes audience questions and discussion].
- **Discussion with Author**
- **Roundtable workshop** (round tables are designed to facilitate high levels of interaction and engagement by utilizing dialogue between the roundtable discussant(s) and attendees. Attendees may visit several roundtables during the session.)

Presentation allocations will be made by the Students for Students National Leadership Committee.

Data projection will be available.

Presenters should supply their own laptops and overhead projectors will also be available. If needed, we may be able to supply a limited number of laptops.

2. Submit a full paper for presentation at the conference.

Submissions need to conform to the Conference specifications for content, format and deadlines as set out below:

- 12-point Times New Roman font
- Information required: Title of Paper
- Authors (underline author/s who will be presenting)

- No indents for new paragraphs; separate with 1 line of spacing

Submitting Full Papers

Once you have been accepted to present, you will need to submit your full paper:
You will be notified of the outcomes of your abstract by Friday 10th July, 2009.

- All papers which are to be included in the conference proceedings are to be sent as an email attachment to presenters@studentleaders.org.au by **Friday, 31st of July 2009**. Same specifications as above. Length: No more than 5000 words
